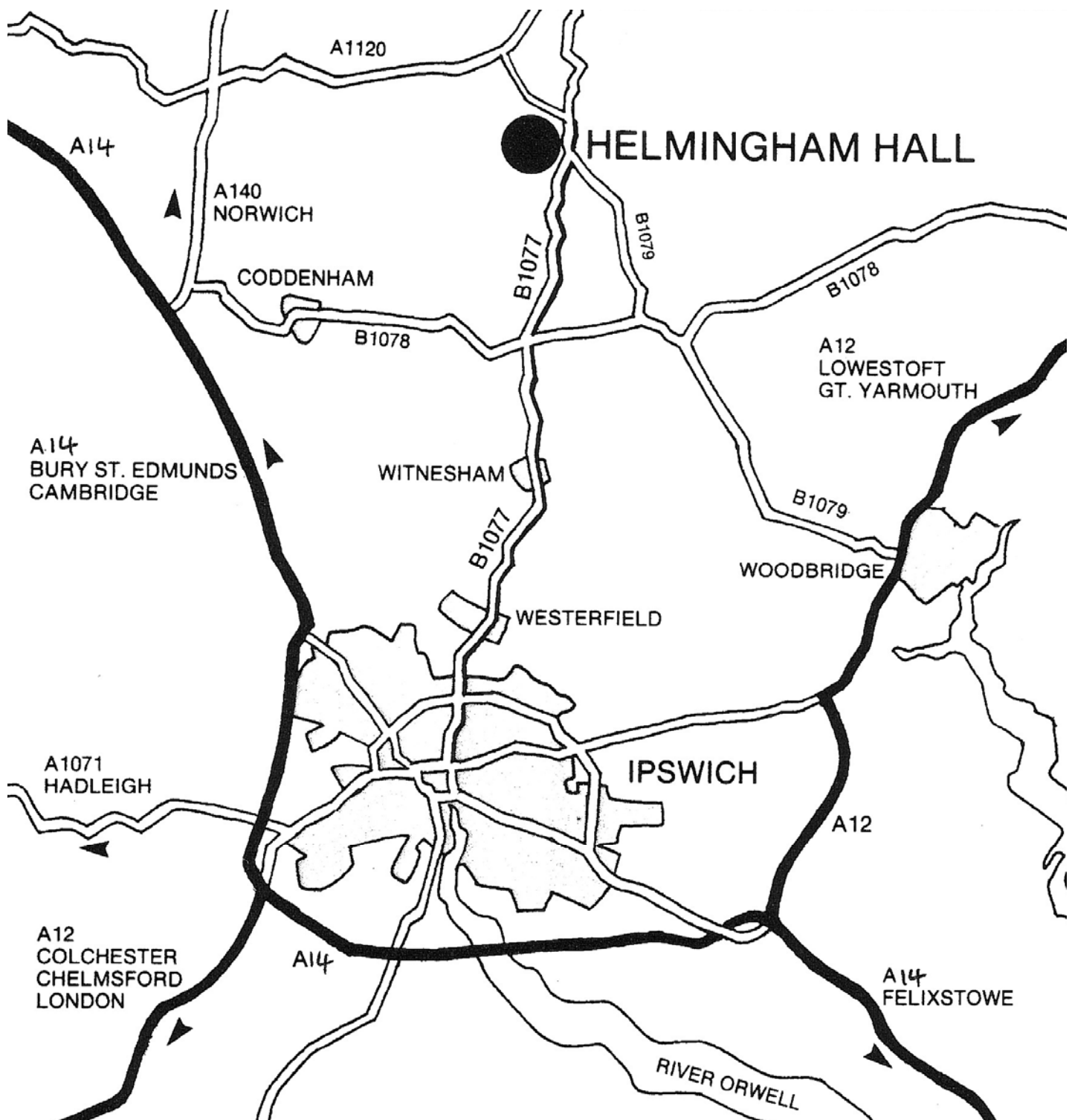

From the North – on the B1077 after the village of Framsdon, the entrance gate for coaches is found on the right-hand-side on a sharp left-handed bend. There are large green & white signs showing that the gardens are open. Please enter here, cross the cattle grid and proceed up the drive.

From the south – on the B1077 you will enter the village of Helmingham. You will first see the front gates to Helmingham Hall on your left - these have large wrought iron gates and a red-brick lodge on either side, **are not wide enough for coach access**. Please carry on past these gates and you will find the visitor entrance on your left at the bottom of a small hill past the church.
